



C&S' Dollars for Doers program supports your interests and commitment as a volunteer in the community. For each hour you volunteer, C&S will donate \$1 to the nonprofit. That means your favorite charity will benefit twice: once from your contribution of time and talent and again from a C&S donation – up to \$1,000 per year.

Make your volunteer service twice as rewarding.

Who can participate?

Any full- or part-time employee.

How do I participate in Dollars for Doers?

- Volunteer for a minimum of 10 hours
- Keep track of your hours during any 12-month period
- Complete and submit the form below anytime during the year
- When approved, a check will be issued to the nonprofit organization
- You must be employed by C&S at the time when the check is issued

What volunteer activities can I do?

Do what inspires you! Here are some ideas:

- Help at a soup kitchen or food pantry
- Assist at a school
- Lead a scout troop or coach a youth team
- Deliver food to seniors through Meals on Wheels
- Walk dogs for an animal shelter
- Join an environmental group cleaning up a park

What nonprofits are eligible to receive a Dollars for Doers donation?

- Nonprofit agencies classified under Section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as charitable, social welfare, health, medical, educational or cultural, and certified as tax exempt under IRS 501(c)3
- Public or private schools
- United Way member agencies

Organizations not eligible*:

- Houses of worship and organizations established for religious, political or special interest purposes
- Veterans, fraternal or social organizations under Section 501(c)4, i.e. Rotary, Kiwanis, Masons, Elks
- Professional associations under Section 501(c)6, i.e. chambers of commerce, trade associations
- Project Graduation and Junior/Senior Proms and all-night celebrations and activities

*Exceptions: If your volunteer service is coordinated through one of the above types of organizations, but clearly benefits an eligible nonprofit agency, that agency may receive a Dollars for Doers donation. For example, if you volunteer for an emergency food pantry at a church, the food pantry is eligible to receive a donation.

Activities not eligible:

- Fund-raising activities such as walk-a-thons (use the C&S Team Up & Make Strides form)
- Charity golf tournaments and other types of fund-raising sporting events
- Travel time
- Company sponsored community activities

C&S Wholesale Grocers, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to decide whether a Dollars for Doers donation will be made and to change or withdraw this program, in whole or in part, with or without notice at any time regardless of the timing of application. The interpretations and administration of the provisions of the program are determined by C&S Wholesale Grocers.
